Services free of charge are available for those in cancer treatment. Individuals may call for free resources on cancer, its treatment and care-giving

Bert Nash Community Mental Health Center, 200 Maine St., Suite A. 843.9192. www.bertnash.org. Serves the mental health needs of Douglas County residents on a sliding scale. Comprehensive, research-based services for families, children and adults include evaluations, individual, group and family therapy plus community outreach.

Douglas County Dental Clinic, 316 Maine St., 312.7770. Serves Douglas County residents at or below 200% poverty level without dental insurance. Proof of income required at time of

Douglas County Visiting Nurses, Rehabilitation & Hospice Care, 200 Maine St., Suite C. 843.3738. www.vna-ks.org. Nurses, therapists, social workers and aides provide in-home health care for those who are ill, frail or have disabilities. CareLink units are available to provide for emergency response.

Hospice provides end-of-life support. Services available include nursing, therapy, aide care, chaplain and social work. Volunteers provide respite to family members and support to the terminally ill patient with six months or less to live.

Early Detection Works 1.877.277.1368 Provides breast and cervical cancer screening, limited diagnostic follow-up testing where appropriate to income-eligible women in Kansas. This program is designed to reduce breast and cervical cancer morbidity and mortality through early detection and treatment.

Haskell Indian Health Center, 2415 Massachusetts St. 843.3750. Serves Haskell students, their Indian dependents and area Indian residents. Provides an integrated outpatient health services program, including mental health, chemical abuse and social services.

Headquarters Counseling Center, 211 East 8th St., Suite C. 841.2345. www.hqcc.lawrence.ks.us. Free counseling and information available 24/7 for children and adults. Provides children's safety education, suicide prevention and bereavement support.

Health Care Access Clinic 330 Maine Street. 841.5760 www.healthcareaccess.org Helps facilitate access to needed healthcare services for Douglas County residents with limited financial means who are not covered by private or governmental insurance programs by way of clinic services, medication and specialist referrals; more than 140 volunteer health professionals and collaborating agencies contribute.

Healthwave 1.800.792.4884 A low- or no-cost medical coverage for Kansas Children. Healwave covers medical, dental, vision, mental/behavioral health and substance abuse services. Emphasizes preventing health problems through regular checkups or minimizing costs through early diagnosis.

Heartland Medical Center 841.7297. 1Riverfront Plaza, Suite 100. A safety net clinic providing services to all on a sliding fee scale, focusing on access to health care for the needy and uninsured. Programs offered include access to medical care, diabetes management, discounted medications, smoking cessation, nutrition/exercise counseling, Early Detection Works Program for women's health, a food pantry, mental health/counseling, and a Pregnancy Care Center. www.leocenter.com

Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department, 200 Maine St. 843.0721. www.ldchealth.org. Immunizations, health screenings, case management for the frail elderly, WIC, family planning, STD services, HIV counseling/testing, pregnancy and parenting case management.

Lawrence Memorial Hospital, 325 Maine St. 749.6100, www.lmh.org. Serves the community's health care needs regardless of ability to pay; emergency services as well as vouchers to receive mammogram screenings. Various other screenings are done free of charge at health fairs throughout the year.

Medicaid 1901 Delaware. 832.3700. Federal entitlement program for low-income individuals that targets children, pregnant women, elderly and disabled. Services include hospital & physician services; prescription drugs; optometry; dental; hearing; home health; rehabilitation; mental health; lab& x-ray; and durable medical equipment.

Salvation Army- 946 New Hampshire. 843.4188. **Penn House**- 1035 Pennsylvania. 842.0440. **Ballard Community Center**- 708 Elm St., 842.0729. Eligibility for medication assistance on case-by-case basis, and is based upon available funding and for certain medications only. Clients must meet income guidelines; program use is limited.

Social Service League, 905 Rhode Island. 843.5414. Provides assistance for vision and hearing needs.

Walgreen's Take Care Clinics, 3421 W. 6th Street, 841.9000. Open 7 days a week; no appointments needed; most insurance accepted. Provides service for everyday family care needs. Drop in for treatment for everything from minor cuts and scrapes to adult vaccinations; allergy relief to ear infections, health evaluations and physicals. Patients 18 months and older.
